

Physics Rules and Information

Below are the lab rules and class information. The student will not be allowed to participate in any of the labs until this sheet is brought back signed.

Safety Lab Rules

1. Students must act responsibly in the lab and follow instructions given by the teacher. Failure to do so may result in the loss of lab privileges while still being responsible for lab reports. Only teacher authorized activities are permitted.
2. Students must take proper care of lab equipment. Students will have to reimburse the school for any broken or missing equipment.

Class information

1. The course is evaluated using two competencies; 1) seeks answers and solutions to scientific problems (quizzes and tests) worth 60 % and 2) makes the most of his/her scientific knowledge (labs, research) worth 40 %.
2. The homework solutions for the year are posted on the course website. Students are responsible for homework and verifying answers. The website is icdt.ca.
3. I will announce assignments on icdt.ca. Checking this website regularly is the best way to keep up with assignments.
4. Students are expected to be present for all tests. If there are any conflicts, students are expected to contact me beforehand (NOT the day of unless it is an emergency) and must have a valid excuse (ex. doctor's appointment).
5. A student has one day of grace to submit an assignment/project/lab. After this they will lose 10% per day for a maximum of 3 days. Weekends count for 2 days. After this a mark of zero will be given. You may submit an electronic copy via email to avoid being late. Please inform me that you are going to do so. The student must hand in a hard copy of the assignment on the next school day.
